ENGLANDER STATEMENT ON SAFE STORAGE ORDINANCE

LOS ANGELES— Today Councilmember Mitchell Englander, Chair of the Public Safety Committee, released the following statement regarding the safe storage ordinance in Los Angeles City Council today:

“Today a statement was released suggesting that my office had postponed the safe storage ordinance that was scheduled to be heard today in City Council. This is simply not true. Having lost a family member to gun violence, I know firsthand the dramatic impact it has on families. It is one of the reasons that motivated me to a life of public service. As a Reserve Los Angeles Police Officer, I firmly believe that this legislation is necessary to protect our community and our children, which is why it has my full support. Additionally, this legislation has been supported by the Los Angeles Police Protective League, the organization that represents our rank and file police officers.”
